The shortlisted submissions are from Ergon Energy Network and Energex (EV SmartCharge), Endeavour Energy (Digital Twin), Essential Energy and Transgrid.

ENA Chief Executive Officer Andrew Dillon said that while the submissions were very diverse, they all had a strong focus on driving networks to a 21st century power grid.

"It's very pleasing to see how networks are innovating to improve system security and reliability and incorporate more renewables onto the grid," he said.
