The Role | Energy Policy Manager

Reporting to the **Head of Distribution**, the Energy Policy Manager works in the Distribution team. The Energy Policy Manager is responsible for supporting the delivery of a range of critical projects, as well as coordinating and organising member committees (the Asset Management, Transmission and Safety Committees).

The role will also manage public policy engagement and development, working closely with our members to achieve beneficial outcomes for customers and the members of Energy Networks Australia.

This is an exciting and challenging position with a salary package that reflects the demands of the role. At ENA, we offer a hybrid working environment, with the flexibility to work in our Melbourne CBD location and remotely by agreement; ideally you will be based in Melbourne, however, other locations will be considered for the right candidate. The role is a permanent full time position with flexible working conditions considered for the right candidate. There will be a small amount of domestic travel required in this role.

Key Areas of Responsibility:

- Lead, coordinate and draft regulatory and policy submissions on behalf of ENA members.
- Independently undertake critical analysis of policy and advocacy related to the energy industry, working with members and external stakeholders to achieve consensus
- Produce public advocacy materials, such as Energy Insider articles
- Assist the networks team in the management and delivery of critical projects
- Organise events on behalf of the Asset Management and Safety Committees
- Provide support to the Asset Management, Safety and Transmission Committees through the coordination of meeting agendas, papers, minutes and work plans.
- Other duties as directed to support the activities of Energy Networks Australia.
