The work of the gas committee is delivered via four strategic themes:

- » Renewable gas advocacy: supporting the near-term role of natural gas and a pathway to renewable gas.
- » Demonstrating the role of renewable gases.
- » Supportive policy developments.
- » Technical leadership and innovation in gas networks.

What the role involves:

- » Represent ENA in renewable gas research activities.
- » Use your data analysis, research and advocacy skills to develop fact sheets on priority issues and prepare reports and energy insider articles.
- » Work collaboratively with other gas industry associations to develop a supportive policy environment for renewable gases.
- » Work collaboratively across the energy supply chain to develop a whole of system approach to reach net zero emissions.
- » Monitor renewable gas developments and maintain watching brief of key issues of interest to Energy Networks Australia members;
- » Act as a contact point for industry liaison on a range of related gas policy matters;
- » Contribute to organisational planning; and
- » Other duties as directed to support the activities of Energy Networks Australia.
